
Labor around the state

- The state's labor force in December was at 3,952,900
- Resident labor force employment rate is at 95.5%
- From December 2020 through December 2021, the state's labor force grew by 122,500
- Over 176,900 people are looking for work

Employment around the state

- The state's nonfarm employment in December 2021 was at 3,445,100
- From December 2020 through December 2021, the state's nonfarm employment grew by 178,100
- Over 250,000 jobs are currently listed by employers

December 2021 County unemployment rates, not seasonally adjusted





Labor in the Region

- Regions labor force in December was at 146,420
- Resident labor force employment rate is at 95.5%
- From December 2020 through December 2021, the regions labor force grew by 5,492
- Over 6,600 people are looking for work









Employment around the Region

- The state's nonfarm employment in December 2021 was at 118,800
- From December 2020 through December 2021, the Regions nonfarm employment grew by 6,100
- Over 4,540 jobs are currently listed by employers



- All Employees, Total Nonfarm, Jan 1990=100








- All Employees: Retail Trade in Kennewick-Richland, WA (MSA), Jan 1990=100









All-Transactions House Price Index for Kennewick-Richland, WA (MSA)

 - Industry and occupational employment trends and projections
 - Wage and benefit information
 - Career information relating to skills and education
- Data are often available at different geographic levels
 - e.g., State, county, metro area, workforce development region, etc.
